The Community Learning Centers have been developed by Greenbush and area school districts in an effort to provide an alternative education for students who have dropped out of school.

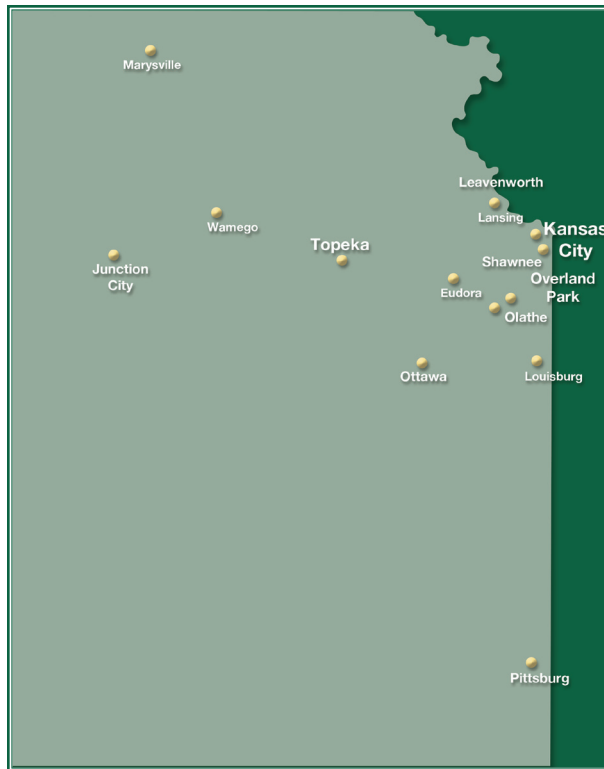

Imagine the Possibilities...

Many students are seeking an alternative to the traditional route of earning a high school diploma.

The Performance-based diploma at the Crawford County Learning Center may be just the alternative students are seeking.

The Crawford County Learning Center is a high school developed by USD 246 Northeast, USD 247 Southeast, USD 248 Girard, USD 249 Frontenac, and USD 250 Pittsburg. The school districts in Crawford County developed the school in an effort to provide an alternative education for students who have dropped out of school. The school is located in Pittsburg and offers flexible hours. Enrollment is \$10. You can enroll at any time.

A motivated student can conceivably complete the course work in much less time than in a traditional classroom. This is because the instruction is highly focused and the student may spend as much time on a given subject per day as they prefer. Upon completion of all necessary credits, a diploma is issued from Pittsburg High School.

The Performance-based diploma program develops general education, academic skills, and proficiencies. In the program, the system of achieving a certain number of credits based on the amount of "time" spent in class has been replaced by the performance standards which must be mastered in language arts, reading, math, science, and social studies.

Students who participate in the Performance-based diploma Program at the Crawford County Learning Center do not attend traditional classes. Instead, they report to a computer lab setting with certified teachers. The teachers design a course of study that meets both the district requirements and the needs of the students. Students may work at their own pace as certified teachers instruct as needed.



Program Benefits

The benefits of attending the Crawford County Learning Center are countless. While students at the school receive a high school diploma, their earning potential increases! Attending the Learning Center helps students to become lifelong learners. Completing course work at the school is the first step for students to begin fulfilling their life long goals.

The Performance-based diploma program is designed to:

- *Keep at-risk students in school.*
- *Lure those who have dropped out of school back to the classroom.*
- *Provide a route, other than traditional high school, for students who desire an educational option.*
