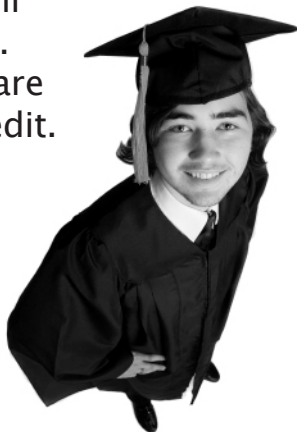
This unique program offers a supportive environment where adults, 18 and older whose class has graduated from high school, may come and earn an Ottawa High School Diploma.

Future Visions offers flexible schedules, allowing students to work at their own pace. Teachers are here to help when you need them. Nighttime hours and summer sessions are also available.

Enrollment is only \$10.00 and your classes are free.

You are eligible for our High School Diploma program only after you have turned 18, and after your original high school class has graduated.

Current High School students from area high schools may enroll in Catch-up Credit classes, with approval from their home high school. Catch-up credits are \$100.00 per ½ credit. Upon completion of a class/classes, these credits are transferred back to the student's home school.
