A motivated student can conceivably complete the coursework in much less time than in a traditional classroom.

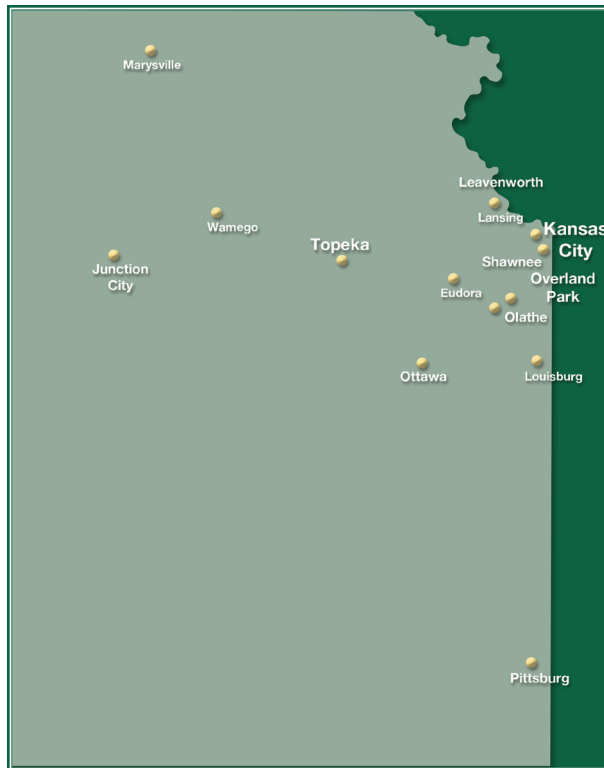

## High School Diploma, an essential step in education!

This unique program offers a supportive environment where students may attend to finish a high school education and earn a high school diploma; sponsored by the Louisburg Board of Education #416. This is a high school completion program and Peoria Street Learning Center offers flexible schedules with daytime and evening hours available allowing students to work at their own pace to complete class credits needed to finish a high school education. Certified teachers are on staff to assist students when needed.

You are eligible for our High School Diploma Program if: #1. You are 16 or older and have completed one year of high school (enrollment between 16 and 18 years of age requires a parent or guardian signature). OR if: #2. You are an adult over the age of 18 and your class has graduated. In fact, we encourage all persons regardless of age to come in and finish your high school education; older credits still apply toward earning a high school diploma. Our programs have computer instructions and are self-paced. Plus we offer all required courses and many elective courses needed.

## Additional programs offered at the center

We have 3 additional programs available for area students and community members.

First, current high school students from area high schools may enroll in our Students for Credit classes, with approval from their home high school. These are classes to 'make up' credits needed toward earning a diploma. Student for Credit classes are \$150.00 per ½ a credit. Upon completion of each class, these credits are transferred to the student's home school.

Second, our center also offers tutorial classes for catching up with concepts or for enrichment for all the grades 1st through 12th grade. The fee schedule is based on the class taken.

Third, we offer classes in various computer programs through Learn Key for any community members. These classes cost \$25 and you are given 6 months to complete the course. You will be oriented at the center, but you will complete the course on your own schedule on your home computer.
