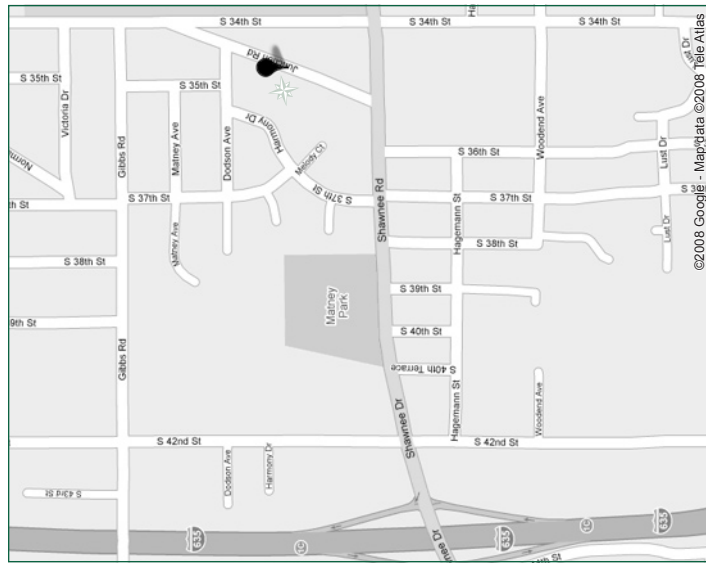

There are many reasons to take a course during the summer. You may need to make up a course you took previously, or you may just want to get a jump on next year so you have more time to take electives or college prep courses next year.

We offer two scheduling options, allowing students to work around summer jobs and family responsibilities. All students must commit to one or both of these schedules. The summer session runs from June 1st thru July 9th. The morning schedule is 9 AM to 12 PM and the afternoon session is 1 PM to 4 PM. Cost is \$175 per ½ credit for students outside of USD 202 and \$125 for in-district.

The Summer School program follows the standard high school curriculum as defined by the Turner School District, and uses computer-based instruction and support from certified teachers.

Enrollment Dates

We will start enrollment May 1st and continue enrollment until spaces are filled.

Space is limited.

Tuition must be paid in full upon enrollment, and the registration form must be signed by a school official.

Enrollment is nonrefundable.

Students may only up for two one-half credit for the summer session. Students are expected to attend one 3-hour block per day, four days a week. We will be open Monday-Thursday and closed on Fridays.

Students are expected to complete one-half credit. Grades will be mailed to parents and the student's high school upon completion of the course.

Students enrolled in the Summer School program agree to abide by the Turner Internet Acceptable Use Policy.

Possession or use of tobacco, alcohol, drugs, or weapons will not be tolerated.

Summer school classes are proficiency-based, self-paced, and computer-assisted. Certified teaching staff and teaching assistants are on hand to assist learners. Because of the learning-lab setting, students are expected to respect others and contribute to a productive learning environment. Turner reserves the right to permanently dismiss disruptive students.

Enrollment forms must be signed by the student, a legal guardian, and a school representative (guidance counselor or principal). Payment must be made in full at time of enrollment. Checks should be made out to SEKESC. All fees are nonrefundable.
