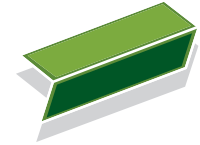
Fall Terms

Enrollment

Space is limited so call early to reserve space.

First-time students must attend an orientation with parent or guardian at either 4:00 pm or 6:00 pm on the first night of the term. Returning students do not need to do this.

Be sure to bring this enrollment form, signed by you, your parent and your principal or counselor. Payment is due in full and is non-refundable.

Students may only sign up for one half-credit per term.

It is recommended that students attend one 3-hour block per day, four days a week until the course work is completed. There will be no scheduled evening classes on Fridays. The center closes at 4:30 pm on Fridays.

Students are expected to complete one half-credit per term. Grades for each semester will be mailed to the student's home district.

Students enrolled in the Students for Credit program agree to abide by the Step Up Internet Acceptable Use Policy.

Possession or use of tobacco, alcohol, drugs, or weapons will not be tolerated.

Classes at Step Up are proficiency-based, self-paced, and computer-assisted.

Certified teaching staff and teaching assistants are on hand to assist learners.

Because of the learning-lab setting, students are expected to respect others and contribute to a productive learning environment. Step Up reserves the right to permanently dismiss disruptive students.

Enrollment forms must be signed by the student, a legal guardian, and a school representative (guidance counselor or principal). Payment must be made in full. Checks should be made out to SEKESC. All fees are nonrefundable.
